RELEVANT AUTHORITIES

- Salons, Personal Care Open 6.15
- Only closed facilities Statewide
 - Residential, Travel and Troop Camps
- Sectors Closed other than MI Sections 6 & 8
 - Gyms and Fitness Centers
 - Casinos, Theatres, Entertainment
- ▶ No General Travel Restrictions
- Social Gatherings
 - > 50 people indoors
 - > 250 people outdoors
 - > 500 in stadiums and arenas



REOPENING REVISIONS – EO 115



- New item for Three Economic Sectors
- ▶ In-Home Services
 - Appointment Record
 - Bad fit
- Salons and Personal Care
- Gyms and Fitness Centers
- Serious Rights implications
 - Tracking at Government insistence
 - Tracking people who are not sick
- Could have broader implications

CONTACT TRACING



- ► In-Home Services (EO 114 ¶10)
 - Job site screening
 - Ask about COVID-19 in home; gloves
- Salons and Personal Services
 - Customer face mask requirements
 - No self-service refreshments
 - Discard magazines
- Gyms and Fitness Centers
 - Workout stations 10 feet or barriers
 - Reduce class sizes
 - Open windows and circulation
- ► Enforcement Nightmare need "inside" help

OTHER NOTABLE RESTRICTIONS



➤ Owosso Barber Case – Manke

- ▶ Court of Appeals Ordered Shop Closed
- Supreme Court Reversed
- Mostly procedural; not the Final Word

▶ Legislature's Case

- Still at Court of Appeals
- ►Supreme Court Denied Fast Track Bypass
- ▶ Refusal is puzzling, inexplicable
- >Attempts at explaining it are weak
- Executive Orders will become OSHA, etc. Regulations
 - The OSHA restrictions apparently apply to Regions 6 and 8
